

WFG CANADIAN JUNIOR CUP SWITZERLAND INFORMATION

DECLARATION

- 1) Prior to a team's first game, Canadian teams must declare whether or not they will be competing for the trip to Switzerland.
- 2) Teams must have 3 original members attending the trip.
- 3) Once a team has made their declaration, whether they choose to compete for the trip or not, this decision will be final.
- 4) Teams should consult their team calendars, and ensure they are not competing in any events during the trip.
- 5) Team should note that if they do not accept the trip, there is no alternative cash prize.

INCLUSIONS:

- 1) Round trip airfare and a checked bag for 4 athletes and from Toronto (YYZ) to Switzerland (ZUR).
- 2) Accommodations for 4 athletes in host cities in Switzerland.
- 3) Transportation for 4 athletes across Switzerland.
- 4) Team entry to the Swiss Cup in Arlesheim, Basel, Switzerland

- Teams not based in Toronto can work with our travel agent to create connecting flight itineraries.

- Teams will be accompanied by WFG Canadian Junior Cup chaperones throughout their entire trip.
- Should a non-Canadian team, or a team who has declared “no” for the trip win the competition, the highest finishing Canadian team who has declared “yes” will be offered the prize.
